Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS)

Admission Requirements

- Level 3 in Chinese Language*; and
- Level 4 or above in English Language; and
- Level 2 in Mathematics (Compulsory Part) and Liberal Studies; and
- Level 3 or above in any two elective subjects.

* JUPAS applicants with very special circumstances may, at the discretion of the faculty deans concerned and on a case-by-case basis, be granted waivers of this requirement.

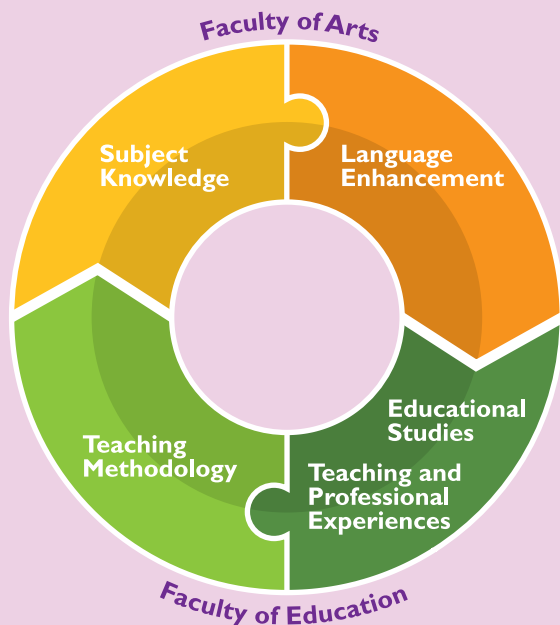

Programme Features

Cross-faculty Programme

The programme is offered by the Faculty of Education in collaboration with the Department of English and the English Language Teaching Unit from the Faculty of Arts.



Three Qualifications in One

- Bachelor of Arts (BA)
- Bachelor of Education (BEd)
- Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) equivalent

Graduates are exempted from the Language proficiency Assessment for Teachers of English (LPATE) at Level 3.



Immersion

Students will have the opportunity to attend an eight- to ten-week overseas language enhancement programme with the financial support from the HKSAR Government. Fulfilment of immersion is mandatory for graduation.

Community of Practice

Platforms for Language Teacher Education (PLaTE) gathers language education students, graduates and front-line teachers in an online dialogic environment for sharing teaching ideas, resources and reflective views.
