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Dr Lawrence Fung is an assistant professor in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Stanford University. He is also the director of the Stanford Neurodiversity Project, director of the Neurodiversity Clinic and director of Dissemination and Outreach Core at Center for Sleep in Autism. His work, which focuses on autism and neurodiversity, traverses from multimodal neuroimaging studies to a new conceptualization of neurodiversity and its application to clinical, educational, and employment settings.
