What Teachers Want from AI (Artificial Intelligence) Experts

Abstract

This seminar will introduce Professor Lee's current project that examines which AI tools teachers desire to use. Data has been collected in April 2023 from an online survey with Australian primary and secondary school teachers. The results reveal Australian teachers' priority areas for AI tool use and predictors of their intention to use AI tools for their daily tasks in schools. Implications for teacher educators, policymakers, IT specialists, and education researchers will be discussed.
