# Objectives

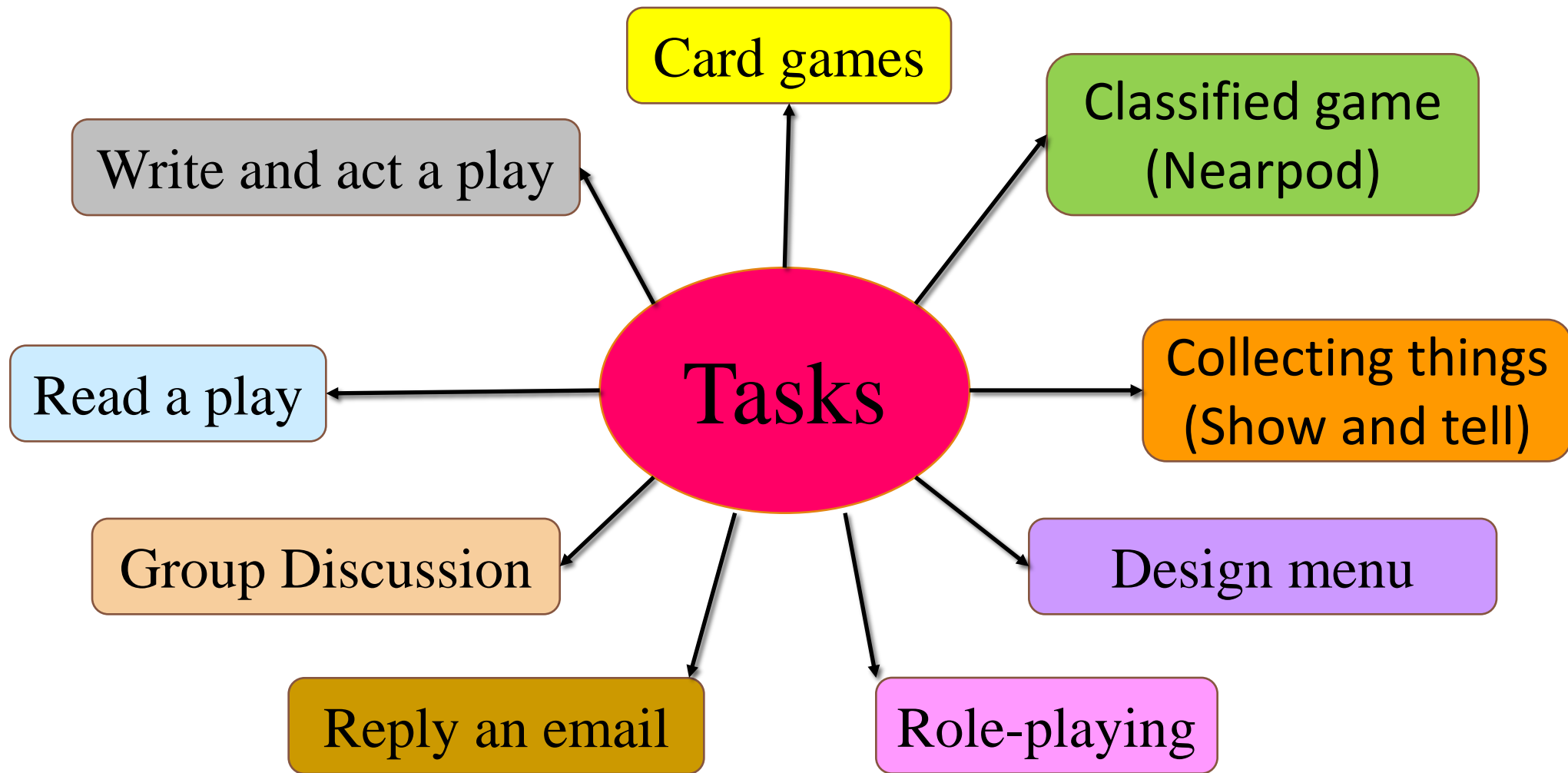

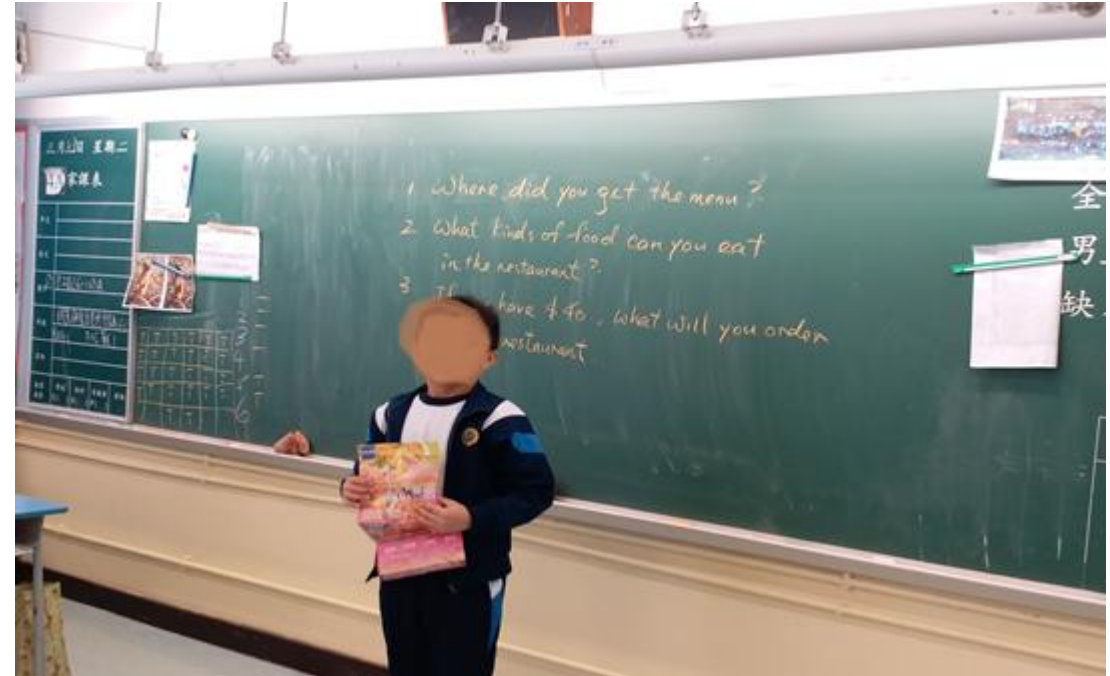
## Learning Activity (3) - Talk about different names of dishes through different card games

Mr Tong : It must be good! Let's go!

All exit.

**Scene 2** In the restaurant

Mrs Tong : Here's the menu.

A menu shows us what food / dishes are available in a restaurant.

**Scene 3** In the restaurant

The waiter brings the food. He hits Mr Tong on the head with a tray.

Mr Tong : Ouch!

Waiter : Oops!

Waiter exits.

Mr Tong : Aargh! I need water! This curry is too spicy! (shouting) Waiter!

Mark : (angrily) Yuck! My food is worse than Dad's. There's a cockroach in my spaghetti. I can't eat this! (shouting) Waiter!

Mrs Tong : (angrily) Urgh! My noodles are cold and there's a hair in this dumpling. (shouting) Waiter!

Mark : This isn't the best restaurant in the world.

Mr Tong : No, it's the worst restaurant in the world.

Mrs Tong : Let's go. I know a better place to eat ...

All : Home!

The end —

**You are Mark. What do you want to say to the waiter?**

In the play, Mr Tong says, "This curry is too spicy!" When you want to say that there is something wrong with the food you eat, you can also say:

- It's too sour!
- It's too salty!
- It's too sweet!

Students are asked to read the play, understand the features and the content of the play.

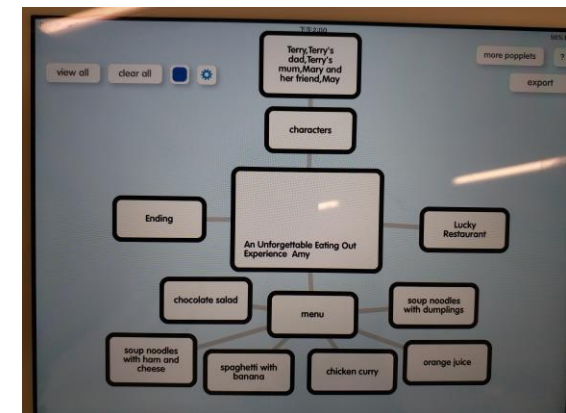
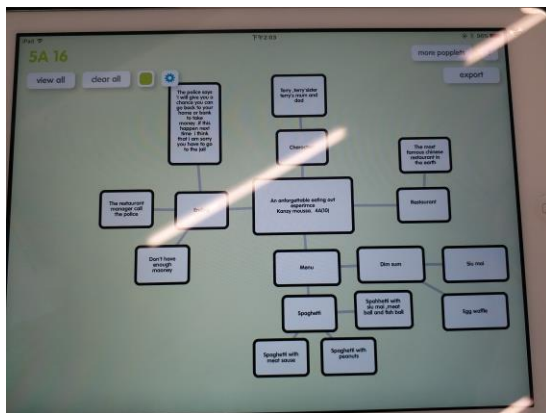
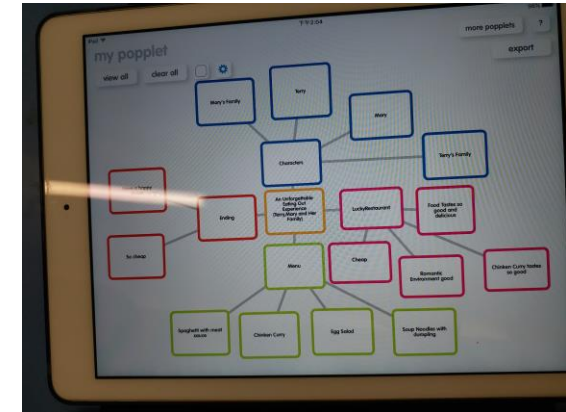
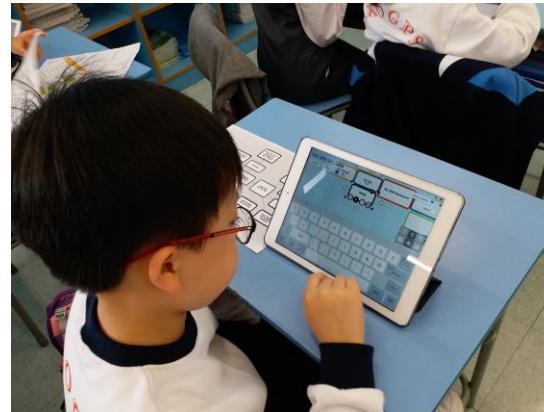
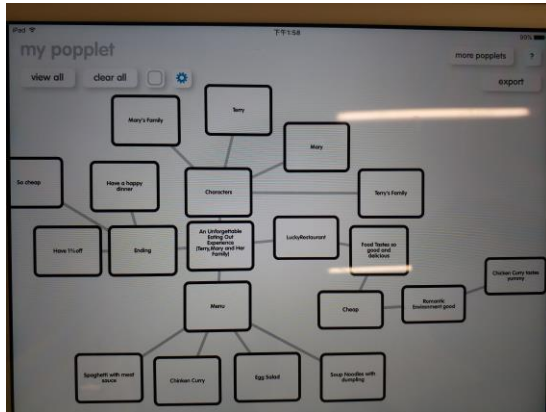
Students are asked to read and reply the email. They are required to discuss with their group members and then choose the best restaurant to have dinner with Aunt Mary and her family.



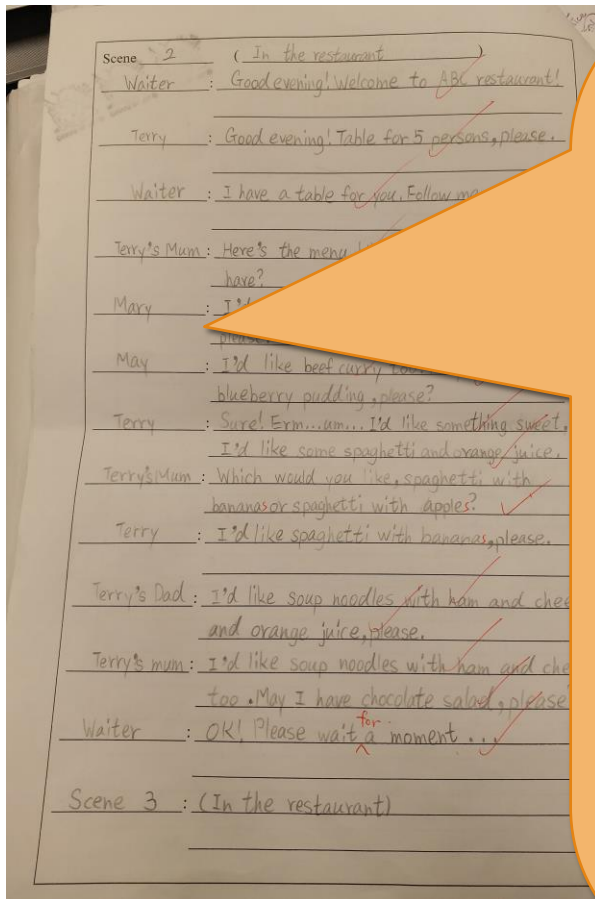


# Learning Activity (9) – Write a new play. What happened when having dinner with Aunt Mary and her family?
