Student Services at Colleges

Guidance on personal and interpersonal problems is also provided by the Dean of Students' Offices at the Colleges. These offices administer College scholarship and bursary awards and also play a vital role in the enrichment of College life. In close cooperation and collaboration with the College student unions and their affiliated societies, the Dean of Students' Offices also oversee the execution of College-wide student activities and programmes.

A wide range of student activities and programmes are offered by the Colleges. These non-formal learning opportunities complement the formal curricula, nurture students' interpersonal skills and cultural sensitivity, and build up their confidence and sense of social responsibility. Besides overseas exchange and student visitor programmes, there are talks and seminars, community service programmes, and training in languages, IT,

leadership, culture and physical fitness.

Student Unions

At present, there is one student union each for Chung Chi College, New Asia College, United College, Shaw College, Morningside College, S.H. Ho College, C.W. Chu College, Wu Yee Sun College and Lee Woo Sing College. All year round, a wide range of activities, including academic, athletic, cultural as well as social functions are organized by the student unions.

師生諮詢會議

Staff-Student Consultative Meeting

由 2007-08 學年起·教育學院的師生諮詢會議透過師生間的意見交流·對學院之課程、教學、評核、制度、措施、設施等方面提出問題及意見·然後將有關意見或決議提交教育學院院務會或各校內外部門及人士回應。師生諮詢會議安排如下:

(1) 高級學位課程

由各課程負責人決定每年諮詢形式·一般以會議或問卷形式向同學提出討論或徵集 意見。

(2) 學位教師教育文憑課程

每年召開兩次諮詢會議,學生代表包括:

「學位教師教育文憑(中學)課程」、「學位教師教育文憑(小學)課程」及「學位教師教育文憑(幼兒教育)課程」

全日制課程:每一「分科課程與教學法」科目之班代表 兼讀制課程:每一「分科課程與教學法」科目之班代表

教育學會:二名代表

(3) 學士學位課程

由各課程負責人決定會議召開形式及學生代表之組成結構。

學生觀察員

學生觀察員的設立是為了收集同學有關課程及學習上的意見、讓學生多了解學院及增加院方會議透明度。而學生觀察員亦可將學院資訊帶給同學,並在院方會議中提出問題或向學院院方反映意見。

Starting from 2007-08, the Staff-Student Consultative Meeting invites staff and current students to have formal discussion on matters pertaining to the curricula, teaching, evaluation, institutions, measures and facilities in the Faculty's domain. It then channels all opinions and resolutions to the Faculty Board of Education and/or other concerned parties for response. The arrangement of the Staff-Student Consultative Meeting is as follows:

(1) Higher Degree Programmes

Each programme decides its format of consultation every year, consultative meetings or surveys are the common approaches used to collect students' opinions.

(2) Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE) Programmes

The Committee meets twice a year, the student representatives include:

PGDE (Secondary) Programme,

PGDE (Primary) Programme and

PGDE (Early Childhood Education) Programme

1 from each full-time SCT

1 from each part-time SCT

2 from the Education Society

(3) Undergraduate Programmes

Each programme decides its format of meeting and composition of student representatives.

Student Observers

The purposes of having student observers are to collect student opinions on curriculum and on matters related to student learning, to let students better understand the Faculty as well as to increase transparency of the Board's meetings. Student observers are responsible for passing updated information of the Faculty to their classmates and reflecting any feedbacks to the Faculty at the Board's meetings.

學生組織

Student Organisations

本院屬下有多個學生自治組織,由不同課程學員籌組而成,其中主要組織包括教育學會、幼兒教育課程系會、語文教育學會、數學及數學教育課程系會、健康與體育運動科學教育學士學會及運動科學與健康教育課程學會。各會社的幹事均由學生自由組閣選舉產生。學會每年舉辦多項活動,包括文娛、康樂、體育及學術各方面,以充實同學之課餘生活。

The Faculty has several student organisations maintained by different academic programmes. The major ones include the Education Society, the Society of Early Childhood Education, the Society of Language Education, the Mathematics and Mathematics Education Society, Society of Physical Education, Exercise Science and Health and Society of Exercise Science and Health Education. Students are free to form cabinets and elect committee members among themselves. These societies organize a wide range of cultural, recreational, sports and academic activities to enrich students' extra-curricular lives.
